

## Cooperative Baptist Fellowship – Spreading the Good News at Home and Abroad

In April we will be receiving an offering for Cooperative Baptist Fellowship (CBF) Global Missions. CBF Global Missions sends field personnel (the term now used for "missionaries") to share the love and compassion of Jesus Christ in around 20 countries and regions around the world. Responding to God's call and empowered by the Holy Spirit, field personnel build community, bear witness to Jesus Christ and seek life-changing development among people who have been forgotten and forsaken by others. Our field personnel serve alongside congregations and local ministry partners.

As CBF Global Missions innovates for the 21st century, a new funding model for mission has been established. The Offering for Global Missions secures the long-term presence of all CBF field personnel, while field personnel raise support from friends, family and other partners to fund their mission programming.

By giving to the Global Missions offering, we become supporters in their work around the world.

Some of the places CBF field personnel serve in the United States include Rocky Mount, NC; Immokalee, FL; Corbin, KY; and Fort Worth, TX. The gospel is also being shared around the world in places like Barcelona, Spain; Kyiv, Ukraine; Kampala, Uganda; Grand Goave, Haiti; North Africa; and Kanazawa, Japan.

We will hear more about the work of CBF on March 10 when Laura Davis, of CBF Virginia, speaks at the worship service.
