Frankly Speaki

Allow me to share with you a "Frankly Speaking" devotional I wrote a few years ago while serving as pastor of First Baptist Church, Sweetwater, Tennessee. The message is still relevant.

"Last week, I uttered words that I never imagined would actually flow from my lips. I said, 'I miss my computer.'

Can you imagine? The Prince of the Pleistocene...The B. C. ("before computers") Caveman...The Last of the Techno-hicans! The most primitive pastor this side of the Reverend Fred



Flinstone, and I really did miss my computer. Last week my hard drive gave up the ghost, taking all of my stored information to the place of the dead, Cyber-Sheol, never to be retrieved again. All of my files are gone forever. And I miss them.

Yes, I know that most gerbils have more computer savvy than I do. Any five-year-old knows to back up all of one's stored information for just such an emergency. Sadly, I rarely carry a five-year-old child with me to work, so I labored in unbacked up indifference for years. And now all of that accumulated 'good stuff' is gone.

It was while my office laptop was in the repair shop receiving a new hard drive (I guess it's kind of like a computer heart transplant) that I once uttered that unimaginable sentence. At the same time, however, church members were in various local hospitals having assorted medical procedures, so I had little time to sit in my office and bemoan my computer's absence. But I did have a few minutes to think about God's grace and the replacement of hard drives.

Every human being has a hard drive Jesus Christ, however, for sin. overrode the human hard drive by dying on the cross, and He offers a completely renovated program to each of us through individual faith. All the old files of sin are wiped away, and a new folder for righteous and abundant life is installed so that all that is holy will be saved, along with our very souls. Just like with electronic computers, I do not understand all that makes the system work, but the blessing is that full understanding is not required for full participation. I only need to trust Jesus and follow Him in obedience to enjoy the blessings of eternal and abundant life.

My computer is back in my office. I will still use it rather reluctantly. I will follow the sage advice of the experts, and I will learn how to back up all that I



want to save. More importantly, I will also follow the eternal wisdom of Jesus and let Him transform me into a new creation (II Corinthians 5:17). I do not want to miss anything that He will download to me."
